We spent \$300 to maintain our web site. However, this next year Dale is taking over and it will only cost us \$50 along with the \$100 that we spend on the maintenance of the web-site. We spent \$2462 on the shirts. We spent \$500 on our Christmas party which included \$186 for food and \$325 for gifts. We registered the trailer for \$47.25. Last year our club insurance went up to \$350 from \$225 the year before. This insurance will be due again in March. David is looking for alternatives. Club members suggested looking up West Bend, and maybe Grundy. We spent \$120 at the swap meet in Hutchinson and \$100 in Ark City to get our booth spaces. We brought in \$1100 for WACO dues from members. We also had some people donate money to our club. The club also earned some money from the swap meets by selling things that members had donated to the club. This was just a brief picture of our financial affairs. David G. reminded us that we have a couple of booths at the Mid America Drag way swap meet in the spring. Before it comes up we need to decide if we want to continue to pay for space at that swap meet.

James shared that he is looking for an original part for his Chevelle. He needs the seal that fits on the cowling that fits on the hood. He said anything from a 68-72 A body should fit. David H. asked where we could get some printing done at a reasonable price. Gerald said he could help with that.
