I would like to add that if you are wanting to enter the Cars for Charity I would send in your registration asap. Reason I say this is that I do not think the round Century II will be here much longer. Plus all of the plans that I have seen shows several buildings with somewhat an outdoor open area, which would mean to me no more connected expo halls. Not sure how you would do a large size show that would require what we have now with Century II (All expo halls combined has 185,000 square feet). This is not including the upstairs area. I have the floor plan layout of all three halls. Currently you can have 710 10x10 spaces. When I was doing "The Chill" at the Pavilions I had 280,000 square feet to use in the beginning. Pavilion 1 alone was 126,000 square feet of display space. So this being said I am sure it will take a couple of years on construction so there won't be a place to do an indoor show in the City of Wichita and then if the floor plans that I saw are correct? Then you have no connection of expo halls to keep people warm for a Winter show going from one building to another.

This is why when I speak with city leaders I tell them that Wichita is desperate for a 300,000 square foot building for large size expo shows. Just my two cents...

Speaking of "The Chill", the floor space is about all sold out. I have maybe about 6 vender spots left and roughly about 80 spots left for Motorcycles. The website is almost complete. I have to make a flyer for the Big Dog Motorcycles Pro-Invitational and then it should be complete. Please see the site at www.thechill.info. I plan on having meetings at the Cessna Activity Center next month for the event staff / people involved. Will have lots of new information then.
